#### Place of Origin: **France**

- ~45% of modern English words are of French origin
- French is the 2<sup>nd</sup>-most widely taught language in the EU
- French is the official language of 29 countries (many of them in Africa)
- the language is monitored and protected by L'Académie Française, founded by Cardinal Richelieu in 1634
